2024 Holdingford Daze Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament Rules

1. *This is an amateur tournament. No Pro or Semi-Pro players are allowed.*
2. *Pool play will be rally scoring.*
3. *Tournament Play Scoring: Rally scoring. Games 1 and 2 are played to 25, must win by 2, with a cap at 27. 3rd game (if necessary) will be played to 15, must win by 2, with a cap at 17.*
4. A team may not have more males than females on the court at one time. Max number of players on the court is 6.
5. Teams are allowed 3 contacts per possession (contact on block does NOT count as contact.) If more than one contact is made per possession at least one of them must be made by a female.
6. Official tournament balls provided MUST be used for all games.
7. Call your own fouls. BE HONEST. In the net, lifts, and double hits are all illegal and result in the other teams point. If both teams cannot agree, then the team that served will re-serve.
8. Volley for the serve. When a 3rd set is played, play rock-paper-scissors. Winner chooses side or serve.
9. All “let” serves are legal and played as normal rally. “Let” serves are serves contacting the net, or those which ride the net falling on the opposing team’s field of play.
10. All poles, trees and other objects are NOT in play and will be considered dead if the ball contacts any object outside the court.
11. A “redo” of the rally will be called if any outside ball or “second court player” enters the court.
12. Show up on time. Any team 10 minutes late forfeits the first set. After 20 minutes the entire match will be forfeited.
13. No blocking or attacking the serve.
14. Dead ball entries only. Late arrivals must wait until the volley is finished to enter the game.
15. These are the official tournament rules, and any in-game occurrences will be referred to these rules.

***Rules, brackets, and times are subject to change until the day of the tournament. Be sure to check for any changes before game play.**

Bracket seeding is based on sets won in pool play among all 8 teams

Tie-breaking:

1. Head to head (if match is split, team with greater point differential wins)
2. Total points scored
3. If 2 teams are still tied, a coin will be flipped
4. If 3 teams are still tied, names will be drawn from a hat to determine their order of finish.
